Leadership COACHING

Are you a coach? Even if you don't coach volleyball, basketball, or any other sport, your teachers, parents, and students are many times looking to you as a "coach" for help in a given situation.

Leadership coaching is about giving you the tools you need to listen to the people with whom you come in contact each day. But it's much more than listening—it's the ability to listen and ask the right questions to empower them to think through their situation and come up with a plan for action. You can "coach" others to be responsible for their situations without owning their problems yourself!

The **Basic Coach Clinic** will train you to ask questions that draw out of a person how they can serve God, problem solving, brainstorming, and action planning as needed. It helps people grow and make decisions without telling them what to do.

This is not a class where you sit behind a table and learn it all from a book; although coaching materials and a best-selling coaching book will be given with registration. This class will provide opportunities to observe, experiment, test and participate in coaching through a variety of settings and situations. It is designed as a coaching laboratory that fast forwards a coach's development and increases his or her effectiveness.

Rev. Terry Tieman will be leading the training. Terry began his career in ministry as a pastor in Michigan and Arkansas. He then served for 13 years as Mission Executive of the Mid-South District of The Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod (LCMS). Terry's experience as a parish pastor, mission executive, congregational consultant and coach, Learning Community facilitator, and trainer of consultants and coaches brings a skill set and perspective that inform and direct the work of the TCN revitalization team. Terry continues to gain front-line experience as Revitalization Pastor at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Memphis, Tennessee. He is also the author of several books, including *Hinges: Opening Your Church's Doors to the Community, Skill Builders, and People of Passion*.
