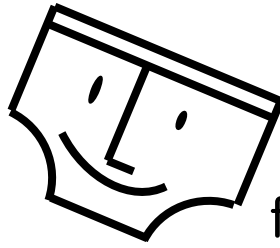


Spare A New Pair

A. Collect **new** undergarments to donate for homeless people. Items should be unused and practical for everyday wear. All sizes are needed for every age. Especially needed are women's sizes 7,8,9 and men's L, XL, XXL.

Also welcome, would be gift cards for Wal-Mart or other discount stores that the shelters could use to purchase undergarments. This would help save with postage.
