

HISPANIC OUTREACH IN SIOUXLAND



Since ESL classes began at Hope, South Sioux City and St. Paul, Sioux City we have been able to offer child care for the families who attend. This has given us the opportunity to share God's Word with the children. With an average of 10 children a night for two nights a week at each church, we have taught Bible stories and songs, made different craft items and played games with the children. Over eighty children have attended at least once since we began in September. Ruthie Witte and several members from the two congregations have shared the love of Christ with these children in Word and deed. Since

January, the teachers have used the VBS materials from previous years produced by Iowa West District. We thank Pastor Riggert and the others who worked to produce these lessons and activities. We hope that the light of Jesus will shine on these children and give them the hope of eternal life.

In South Sioux, the area 4-H resource person has come on several occasions to lead the children in different educational activities related to nutrition, food preparation, money, and the appreciation of other cultures. We hope that the families would come to know and take advantage of this program for their children.
