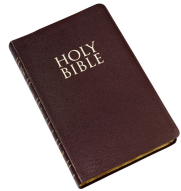
SEE THE NEED, FILL THE NEED

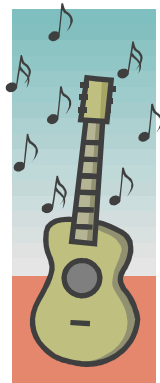

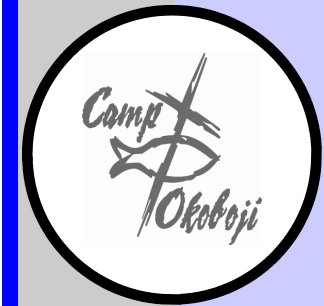
