Did you know that your congregational mission dollars support the District budget in a variety of missions, programs, projects, and activities? This month, the part of the budget that is highlighted is IOWAY (Individual Outreach With Adults and Youth). The budget supports this ministry by providing \$60,000 to cover this mission. This ministry began in August 2001 with the great leadership of Ellie Menz for 21 years. Julie Mann took over the reins in June 2023. She continues to increase mission and human care awareness and encourage servant experiences in the congregations, communities, District, and beyond. # December 2023

This issue of The Messenger includes the congregational giving from the fiscal period February 1-October 31. Thank you to all congregations for your mission and ministry support. Praise God for congregations' generous giving and thanks to the four circuits for 100% mission and ministry support (Boone, Le Mars, Sac City, and Storm Lake). The total 2023 District budget is \$2,561,733 of which 57% directly supports missions! ### November 2023

It is not only safe but you are also investing in the future of the church. LCEF loans money to churches and schools for new construction and renovation to make space and place for ministry. ### October 2023

Did you know that your congregational mission dollars support the District budget in a variety of mission and ministry areas? The current budget includes \$306,550 for congregational services. This includes the areas of education, youth, stewardship, and President's office. The staff is available to connect, resource, and partner with your congregation.

# September 2023

Did you know that your congregational mission dollars are supporting a variety of mission and ministry efforts all across the District? The 2023 budget includes \$828,900 (almost 1/3 of the budget) for District missions. This is an increase of \$67,700 from the mission budget last fiscal period. Mission dollars provide support for the Executive Assistant and several other mission areas: IOWAY/Julie Mann, mission grant partnerships (significant grants to St. Paul, Ankeny mission plant; Hispanic Missions/Rev. Pedro Lopez; Grace, Le Mars Sudanese missions; and Shepherd of the Valley Hispanic ethnic mission). Your congregation's contributions continue to support mission efforts all across the District for the extension of the Kingdom!

## August 2023

The District provides post-college assistance to pastors and professional church workers for the sole purpose of providing grants to reduce educational indebtedness. Funds will be disbursed directly to the lender. This is the 10<sup>th</sup> year of providing grants. Applicants must complete a detailed application (<a href="www.idwlcms.org">www.idwlcms.org</a> and click on "Resources" and "Forms & Links") as well as the worker's congregation and financial planner. ### **July 2023**

The District supports a number of worthy mission projects, programs, and activities. This month, the part of the budget "**preparing church workers**" is highlighted. When I started 25 years ago, the District's annual support for students studying at Concordia schools was around \$60,000. Today, that amount has grown to over \$250,000. The increased support has come from endowment and restricted funds as well as support from the LWML, individuals, and congregational gifts. At the end of August, the schools/students will begin to receive the fall financial aid support from the District. Thank you for your congregational and individual gifts as we joyfully support our future pastors and church workers so they can pass the Christian faith on to the next generation.

#### **June 2023**

Did you know that in addition to your congregational mission dollars, the District budget is supported by other income sources including **Lutheran Church Extension Fund operating results**? The total support for this fiscal period is over \$62,000. These funds support ministries in the District that might not otherwise be possible. Some of these projects include Congregation/School Resources, Church Planting, Rostered Worker Resources, Mission Grants, and other mission and ministry projects. Did you know that your congregational mission dollars support the District budget in many mission and ministry areas? The District strongly supports **missions** with almost 2/3 of the budget: 1/3 for Synod missions and 1/3 for District missions. This total, \$ 1,411,372, is almost the same as the congregation mission support budget for the fiscal period. The remaining 1/3 of the budget covers congregational support services (Human Care, Education, Youth, Stewardship) and administrative expenses. Your dollars make a difference in carrying out the mission and ministry in Iowa District West and across the world.
